BEST TIME TO SNORKEL

Best time of day to snorkel is on an incoming or high tide, visibility will decline as tide goes out. And almost always first thing in the morning as marine life leave the area throughout the day.

Best time to visit is on a day with wind less than 15 knots ideally south easterly. Best visibility will be after a week of low wind, no rain and small tides.
