The Rip Snorkel

Between one end of Direction Island and what's left of neighbouring Prison Island is a channel of water known as The Rip. Water feeds in from the ocean over the outer reef, funnels between the two islands and empties into the Cocos Lagoon.

From West Island in the Cocos Islands, there is a twice weekly ferry services to the uninhabited Direction Island. From the Direction Island Wharf, turn right and it is a 10 minute walk to The Rip snorkel site at one end of the island.
