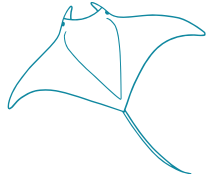

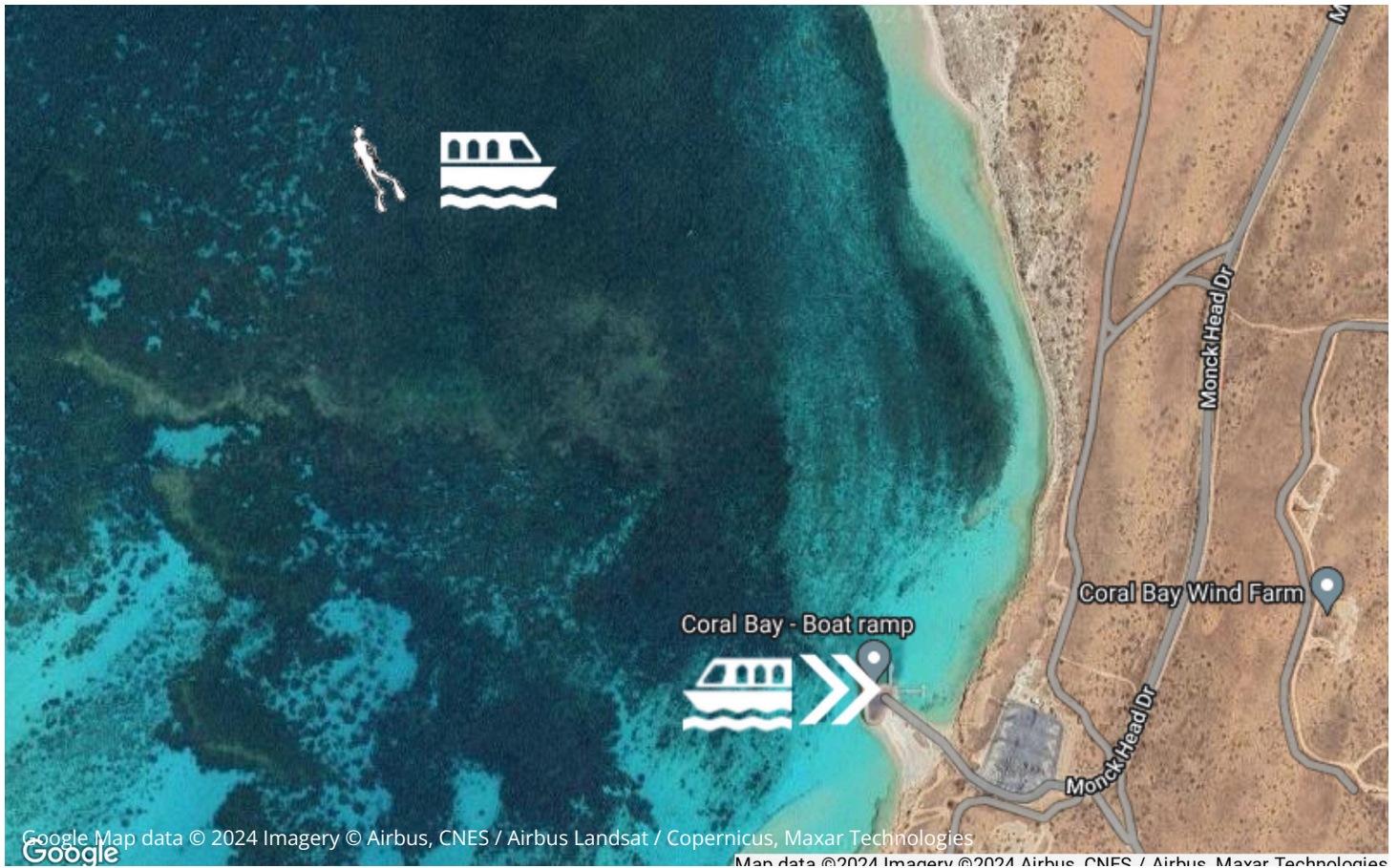

The bus departs from Bills Bay in Coral Bay to take you to the boat ramp. Coral Bay is 1100km north of Perth on the Coral Coast which is part of Ningaloo Reef.

BEST TIME TO SNORKEL

There are manta rays in the water at Coral Bay year round. For the best weather, head to Coral Bay from April to October. Outside of these months it can be very hot and humid - not a problem in the water but it's pretty awful when you are on land.
