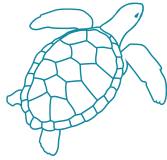

## GETTING THERE

The departure point for this tour is Deeral which is 45 minutes south of Cairns. Tour operators will transfer you there. From Deeral it is a 30 minute cruise to Normanby Island which is part of the Frankland Island Group.

This is a great tour for families and snorkellers of all experience levels. You snorkel right off the beach. Even if snorkelling is not your thing, there is a semisubmersible tour as well as a guided snorkel included in the cost of tour.

## BEST TIME TO SNORKEL

Being close to the mouth of the Mulgrave River, the water can get murky here if there is significant run off - which there is during the wet season from December - March. Much better here in the dry season from April to October.
